- 2. All competition times are approximate. Please be ready to dance one hour before your scheduled time. The Feis Committee will call a missing entrant three times maximum. Competitors who fail to appear when called will forfeit their right to participate in that particular competition. We will not delay a competition for any reason.
- 3. Competitions will be combined if the numbers warrant that decision.
- 4. Awards will be posted in a timely manner.
- 5. We wish to remind you Rule 29: In consideration of safety and in fairness to dancer performing at a Feis, photography of any kind which has the capacity of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is strictly forbidden.
- 6. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.

Beginner level dancers must dance St. Patrick's for Traditional Set. Novice & Prizewinner level dancers may dance other Traditional Set dances.

*PANDA stands for "People Acting Now Discover Answers." It is the nickname for the Phoenix Women's Board of the Steele Children's Research Center at the University of Arizona. PANDA is committed to raising funds to improve treatments and develop cures for devastating childhood diseases. PANDA is proud to fund and recruit internationally recognized physician-scientists investigating a wide range of pediatric disorders. The Steele Children's Research Center at the U of A is the only pediatric research hospital in the state of Arizona, and is one of the U of A's 15 Centers of Excellence. The 2019 event proceeds will help fund the PANDA Personalized Pediatric Medicine Project and endowment. The objective of this project is to conduct pilot studies and establish an integrated system for personalized medical approaches to treat children suffering from complex diseases including cancer.
