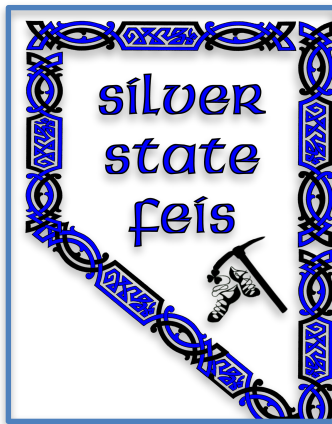

Feis Check-in: Sat April 14 7:30 am
Dancing begins: Sat April 14 8:30 am

Teams: 8.30-9:00am

Solos won't begin until ALL teams are finished.

Grades:

Morning: all Teams(beginner/open/adult), all Novice, Prizewinner, Adult competitions,
Specials will be held after Traditional Sets are done.

Afternoon: Choreography Special after lunch, before the solo competitions resume.
All First Feis, Beginner, Beginner 2
Specials after Traditional Set

Champs:

Start with the youngest prelim and open and continue in order through to the oldest.

*Will allow for afternoon dancers in choreography special to change before those competitions commence.
**If there is a schedule change that differs from the above, the changes will be listed by May 28.

- No videotaping of dance competitions **except** for **first feis**. No flash photography of any kind for the safety of the dancers.

LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION (PLEASE INCLUDE IN YOUR SYLLABUS)

First Feis is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer.

Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back Feiseanna. They may not compete in any other level besides first feis on the day.

In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply:

5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade

10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade

Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion.

Prizewinner: Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

Preliminary to Open Championship: Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of competitions for 5 years.

Beginner Figures: Open only to dancers in beginner for at least one solo dance.

Open Figures: Open to all grades levels.

Will combine age groups where necessary.

Will run prelim and open concurrently where necessary depending on numbers.

Make sure to check the final schedule for these adjustments.

Solo Competitions

*In order to move up in a dance, a minimum of 5 dancers must have danced in that competition.

*Competitions with 4 entries or less may be combined.

Championships
