### FFIS RULES

- 1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission www.northamericanfeiscommission.org are included by reference.
- 2. Flash photography and the use of video recording devices are strictly prohibited. The Feis may elect to have a professional photographer present for publicity purposes only.
- 3. First Feis entrants may not compete in the same dance in a higher category.
- 4. Any competition with less than 5 competitors may be combined with next higher age group.
- 5. Competitors must be at the stage, prepared to dance, at least fifteen minutes prior to the beginning of their scheduled event.
- 6. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
- 7. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
- 8. Championship competitions are awarded by the entire adjudicator panel; individual rounds will be awarded based on one, randomly selected, adjudicator's scores as in solo competitions.

Awards will be announced throughout the competition day. A tentative schedule will be provided with your registration materials and posted throughout the venue.
