Championship Requirements:

Open Championship

- Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars)
- Double Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (40 bars)
- Set Dance (Traditional Set Required in U9)

Preliminary Championship

- Reel (32 bars) or Slip Jig (32 bars)
- Double Jig (32 bars) or Hornpipe (32 bars)

Please note: Dancers will perform two at a time on a 60' split stage. Each dancer will have an area 30' across and 24'

WESTERN US REGION LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION

- **First Feis** is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. A dancer has only one 'first feis' regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.
- In **Beginner 1, Beginner 2 and Novice** the following will apply:
 - 5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade
 - 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade
- Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion, with the exception of back-to-back feiseanna.
- **Prizewinner:** Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.
- **Preliminary to Open Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.
- **Adults:** Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of conventional competitions for 5 years.
- **Beginner Figures:** Open only to dancers entered in beginner for at least one solo dance.
- **Open Figures:** Open to all grades levels.

DANCING COMPETITION RULES

1. Competitor's age will be determined as of January 1, 2021.
2. Dancers must be pupils of a certified teacher registered with CLRG, IDTANA and their regional council.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions for which they are not registered will not be eligible for placement or awards.
4. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
5. The McTeggart Irish Stepdancers of Colorado, the Feis Committee and anyone associated with the Committee in presenting the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event. By entering this feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless this feis, the feis committee, volunteers, vendors, and venue for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in this feis.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL MUSIC - Competition 950

Entries may be divided based on instrument and age. Soloists only.

Requirements:

- Only traditional Irish or Scottish music will be accepted.
- Electronic or amplified instruments will not be permitted, with the exception of keyboards.
- Instrumental: Play two tunes of contrasting tempos. 2 minutes maximum per tune.
- Vocal: Perform one song. 3 minutes maximum.
