Note: The Feis Committee has the option of splitting or combining competitions as necessary based on registration.

LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION

First Feis: It is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.

In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply: 5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade, 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade. Dancers <u>may not</u> stay in level at Teacher discretion **Prizewinner:** Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion. **Preliminary to Open Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.

Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of competitions for 5 years

This is a blind treble reel competition in which each dancer will perform **16 bars of a treble reel** and be judged solely on rhythm. This special honors the memory of Kathleen Deely and celebrates excellence in traditional Irish dance.

Family Special #931

The **Family Special** is open to any dancing family members who wish to participate together. Dancers will perform a **32-bar routine to a reel**, showcasing teamwork, creativity, and family spirit. This non-traditional special is a fun opportunity to celebrate the joy of Irish dance across generations and family connections.
