Rules:

1. The Feis is registered with the Western U.S. Region of the The Irish Dancing Commission and will follow the rules thereunder.
2. Competitor's age will be determined as of January 1, 2022.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement and awards.
4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
5. Competitors must be at the stage, prepared to dance, no more than thirty minutes prior to the beginning of their scheduled event.
6. The Wick School of Irish Dance, Colorado Celtic Dance Association ("CCDA") and Hilton Denver Inverness will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage incurred before, during or after the Feis. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the CCDA, Colorado Winterfeis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, Hilton Denver Inverness and the Wick School of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

Note:

- * Every effort will be made to split or combine competitors where it will most benefit all dancers.
- * Times and competition stage locations are subject to change, even during the competition day.

Covid 19 Modifications:

Please note that any or all parts of the syllabus, including the number of dancers on stage, the number of required dances or steps or an entry cap, may change in response to State, County, and Local Covid regulations. Feis organizers reserve the right to amend the syllabus up to the date of the Feis. Please expect that masks will be required and dancers may be limited to one spectator per dancer. Dancers will not be required to wear a mask while dancing.

Level Advancement and Definition:

First Feis is not per dance, it is the first feis ever for the dancer, regardless of how many dances the dancer is doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in the case of back-to-back feiseanna.

Beginner 1, Beginner 2, and Novice

- * 5-9 Dancers - 1st Place advances to the next grade level.
- * 10 or more dancers - 1st and 2nd places advance to the next grade level.
- * *Dancers may not stay in a grade at teacher discretion, with the exception of back-to-back feiseanna.*

Prizewinner - Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

Preliminary to Open Championship

- * Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers. Not at teacher discretion.
- * Upon the 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championship, a dancer must immediately move to Open, even in the case of back-to-back feiseanna. This includes 2 and 3-round Preliminary Championships.

Adults - Dancers who started dancing after the age of 18 or who have been out of competition for 5 years.

Competition and Awards Details:

- * All results will be posted online on Feisworx. There will NOT be a results room with posted results.
- * Only Championship Competitions will be announced.
- * First Feis - Prizewinner Dancers may pick up their medals at a designated location (TBD).
- * All dancers are responsible for printing their own dance cards prior to arriving at the feis.

Preliminary Championship - Open to dancers who have NOT won 3 firsts in their overall Preliminary Championships with 5 or more dancers. Immediately following a 3rd first place, dancers must move to Open Championships, even in the case of back-to-back feisanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round championships.
