## **LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION**

**First Feis:** It is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.

**In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply:** 5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion **Prizewinner:**

Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion. **Preliminary to Open**

**Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.

**Adults:** Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of competitions for 5 years

\*Note: The Feis Committee has the option of splitting or combining competitions as necessary based on registration

### Champion of Champions Special #920

The RMIDA Championships will conclude with the Champion of Champions Special, open to all dancers competing in Preliminary or Open Championship who have won their overall championship event. Eligible dancers will perform one light shoe step (16 bars) down the line. One overall winner will be selected and awarded the title of Champion of Champions.

## **Western US Region Junior Belt - Competition #925**

Open to all Open U14-U16 Championship level dancers residing in the Western US Region. Adjudicated by a panel of 5 judges. Dancers will perform: Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars), and Treble Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (40 bars), and 1 Set Dance. Where there are 20 or more, there will be a recall for the set dance round. Less than 20, all dancers will dance their set dance. Awards given to 1/3 of the competitors up to a maximum of 5 places. The winner will receive \$500 from the Western Region.
